The Child Advocacy Center of Hillsborough County is based on a nationally recognized model that works closely with area police departments, child protection services, prosecution, victim advocates, mental health providers, pediatricians and schools. At our Nashua and Manchester centers, we provide a neutral setting for joint investigations, forensic interviews, case tracking and referrals to community agencies for child victims of crime and their families.

On average, the Child Advocacy Center serves approximately 600 child victims of crime per year. Most are victims of sexual assault while others are victims of physical assault or a witness to a violent crime such as a homicide.

The Child Advocacy Center is a private non-profit organization and much of the success of our small agency stems from community support in ways of volunteering, donations, and awareness. 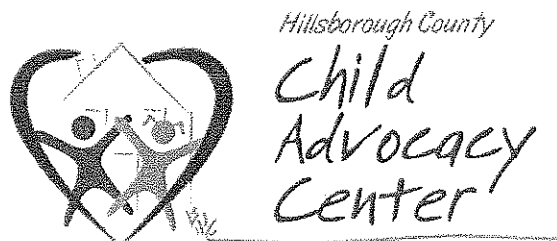
